The School:

The Heritage School was founded on 25th June 2001 by Kalyan Bharti Trust, a philanthropic and charitable organization consisting of twenty-two Kolkata based leaders of industry, committed to the cause of excellence in education. The School, which is co-educational and affiliated to the CISCE, offers quality education to children from Pre-Nursery to Class 12. Its 10 acre campus is characterized by modern and aesthetic buildings in sylvan surroundings, and a state-of-the-art infrastructure for academics, co-curricular activities, and games & sports.

Admission:

Candidates who have appeared for the ICSE or equivalent examinations from English medium schools are eligible for provisional admission which will be considered for confirmation after the ICSE or equivalent examination results are out.

Admission Criteria: Required minimum percentage in pre-board examinations for issue of forms and eligibility to appear for admission test:-

Science	: Aggregate 70%
Commerce	: Aggregate 60%
Humanities	: Aggregate 60%



The ISC programme:

This is a two year course followed in Classes 11 and 12, leading to the award of the Indian School Certificate, a premier school leaving qualification recognized nationally and internationally.

In addition to English, which is compulsory, students will have to do five electives. From the following subject combinations, students could choose one.

Children from all streams have to choose one subject from Group V which has the following subjects: Hindi, Bengali, Art, Physical Education, Elective English

The following documents would be required:-

- 1) Attested copy of Classes 9 & 10 report card of the school last attended.
- 2) Attested copy of the marks statement of the ICSE or equivalent examination.
- 3) Attested copy of the Admit card of the ICSE or equivalent examination.
- 4) Migration certificate (for students of other Boards, in addition to the above)
- 5) Conduct certificate.
- 6) Migration Certification. } *To be submitted only after the candidate is selected.*

Class Timings:

7.20 a.m. to 2.10 p.m., with a possibility of special classes on select days.

Meals:

Nutritious, vegetarian food (breakfast, lunch, snacks), prepared in a hygienic and modern catering facility, will be provided in a centrally air-conditioned dining hall.

Transport:

All the students of The Heritage School travel in air-conditioned buses provided by the School. Students are picked up from, and dropped at, bus stops located within a 1 km. radius of their homes.

Counselling:

Counselling is an important and integral part of our School. A team of counsellors and teachers alongwith the Counselling Psychologist provide pastoral care to all the children.

Uniform:

Regulation belt to be worn by all students.

Navy blue trousers/knee length skirt, small blue and black checks on white shirt/blouse, white socks and black regulation shoes.

Grey pullover in winter.

Grey blazer, navy blue trousers/knee length skirt, white full sleeved shirt, school tie, white socks and black shoes, for formal occasions and/or winter.

Blue track pants with House T-shirt for yoga and games.

Students of The Heritage School are expected to be simple and modest in their appearance.

They must be impeccably turned out with clothes properly washed and ironed.

Boys must wear their hair short, and be clean shaved, unless otherwise sanctioned due to reasons of religion or custom. Streaking and unconventional hairstyles are not permitted. Boys are not allowed to use earrings or other decorative accessories.

Girls are not permitted to use make-up or jewellery other than a simple pair of earrings. Mehendi, colouring and streaking are not allowed. Hair should be either cut short or tied neatly with a simple black hair band.



Discipline:

At The Heritage, we believe that discipline and order in our day-to-day lives are the key to a happy, healthy and productive life. We expect respectful, obedient, courteous and helpful behaviour of our students at all times.

A student's conduct, and norms regarding use of personal effects will be governed by school rules and regulations, which will be communicated to the applicant as soon as he/she becomes a part of the Heritage family. Offer of admission is conditional on the implicit acceptance of the School's code of conduct.
