The Grand Finale of the Symposium on Anonymizer Hackathon was organized by the Department of Information Technology and Electronics, Government of West Bengal at the Biswa Bangla Convention Center on 12 August, 2023. This grand finale was a nine month initiative to develop India's first data Anonymiser through a hackathon with more than 650 registrations. 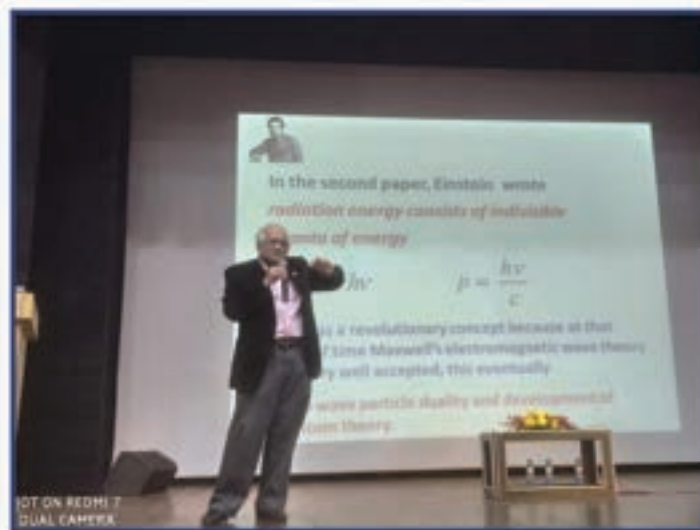

The delegates' visit commenced with an engaging tour of the building, Abhiyakti which is the Activity Block of the school, providing them with insights into the school's holistic educational facilities and environment.

The highlight of the visit was a captivating program organized by the school, showcasing how various United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs) are effectively integrated into the school's projects. The event commenced with a ceremonial lamp lighting, symbolizing the illumination of knowledge and understanding.

Distinguished guests included Dr. Misuzu Asari, Associate Professor from Kyoto University, Japan, and Prof. Sadhan Kumar Ghosh, President of ISMWAW, who addressed the audience on behalf of the Japanese delegation. 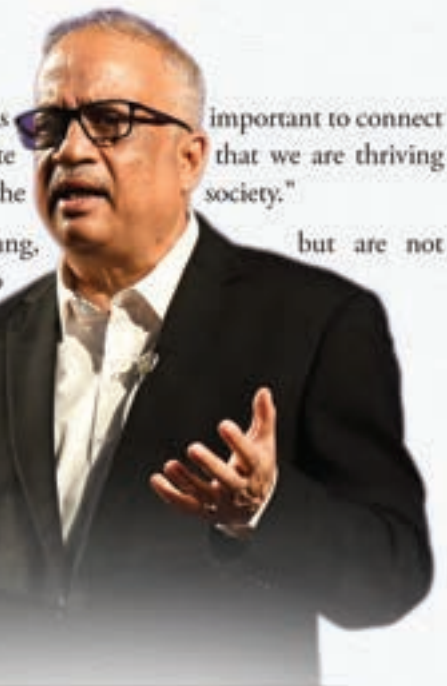

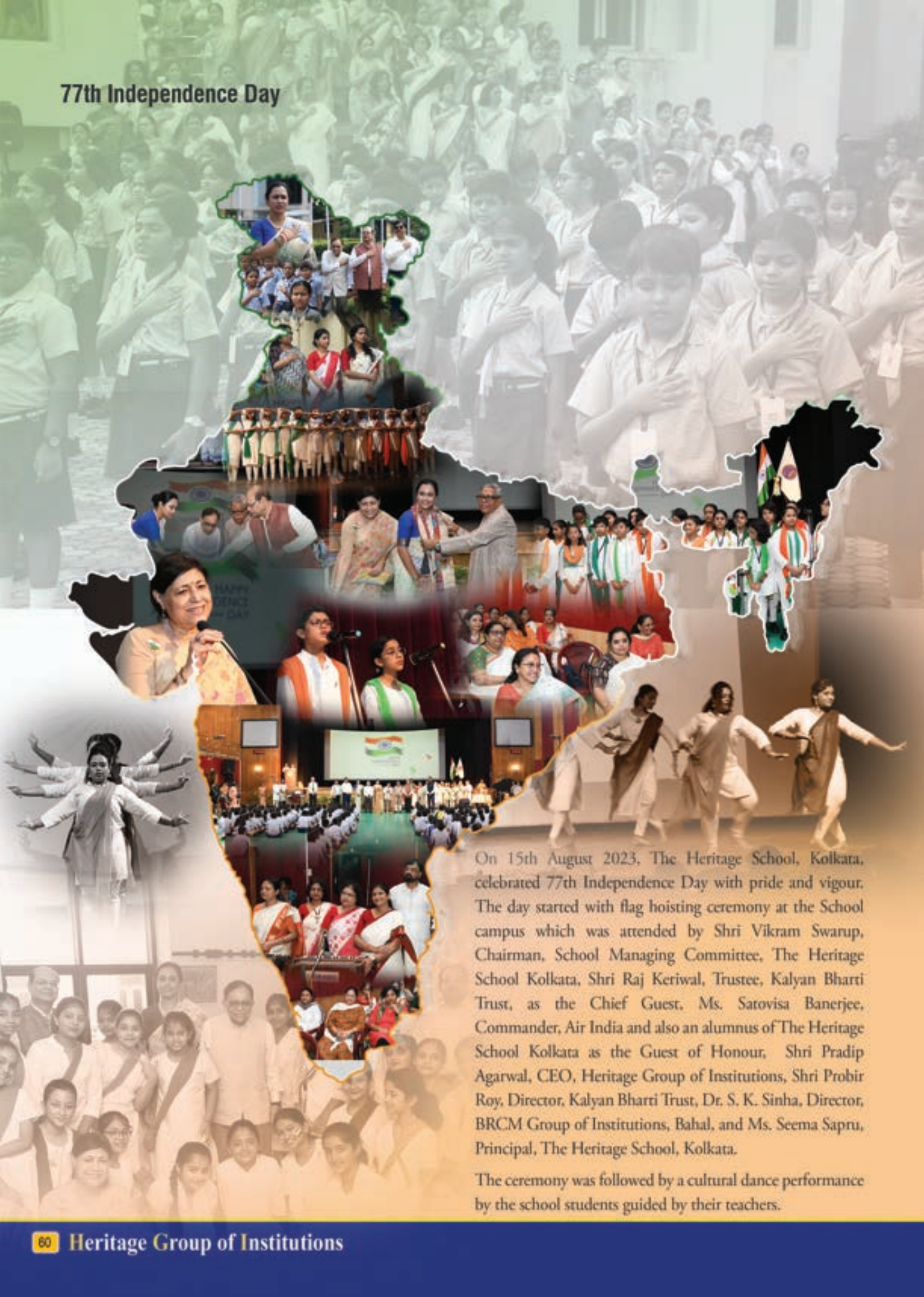




## Jungle Book Re-Visited
